In line with this year's theme of UK Black History Month ("Standing Firm in Power and Pride"), this exhibition features the portraits and short biographies of the Black philosophers whose academic work, speeches, publications and pioneering activist roles had a profound worldwide influence on many future artists, professionals and activists from all backgrounds – not limited to Black followers.

The exhibition features 11 female and 7 male philosophers.

Throughout October, EuroMernet Film Club will also screen drama and documentary films on Black History, including films about the life and legacy of some of the philosophers who were featured in the exhibition.


